

# NSW AUCTIONEER ACCREDITATION

With clearance rates at auction sitting even higher than last year and 63.7% of properties clearing under the hammer in February 2024, having the ability to auction properties is highly valuable within the NSW Real Estate market, especially with Sydney being the best-performing auction Australian city. \*

## WHY GET ACCREDITED?

In NSW, you need an Auctioneer Accreditation to conduct auctions of property, land (including rural land) or livestock.

## TO QUALIFY

- You must hold a NSW real estate agent licence or a stock and station agent licence (Class 1 or Class 2),
- AND complete specific training to be eligible to apply to NSW Fair Trading for this accreditation to be added to an existing Class 1 or 2 Real estate or Stock and Station Licence.

## UNITS OF STUDY

You will need to complete three units of required study to be able to hold your Auctioneers Accreditation. There are:

- **CPPREP4161**, Undertake pre-auction processes
- **CPPREP4162**, Conduct and complete sale by auction
- **CPPREP4163**, Complete post-auction process and contract execution

## KEY COURSE DETAILS

**Duration** - 4 hours (approximate)

**Location** - Parramatta, or Zoom for regional/rural students

**Pre-Work** - There is some pre-work included

**Assessment** - One assessment covering all three topics
